Subject Overview 2015-16

History and Geography are core subjects at Hucklow. History enables children to develop a coherent knowledge and understanding of Britain's past and that of the wider world. It inspires pupils' curiosity to know more about the past.

Geography equips pupils with knowledge about diverse places, people, resources and human environments. It combines these elements together to deepen understanding of the Earth's key physical and human processes.

Speaking, listening and communication are promoted while children talk about their own ideas and experiences. This leads to a deeper shared understanding of the subject.

History and Geography are taught through topic lessons for 1- 2 hours per week. Children will evidence their learning in art, writing, photographs, music ,technology and speaking and listening. This will be recorded in Curriculum books and Class Handbooks.
