How We Will Spend Our Allocation:

This year we will continue our commitment to the Arches School Sports Partnership by signing up to the 'GOLD' package to be able to access further CPD for more members of staff, as well as all of this year's competitions on offer to the children. Our NQT staff and staff that have moved year team this year are keen to increase their subject knowledge and so they are being targeted for a number of CPD courses which will help us to evaluate the impact of improved teacher delivery.

Arches are also providing leadership and coaching opportunities for our Year 5 children where school will continue to promote the School Sports Crew. 5 children will be selected to become members of the sports crew who will help to provide a pupil voice on sport through blogging and other activities whilst helping to put ideas in place to improve non-participants' desire to take part and enjoy sport.

We will again be bringing in Arches sports coaches to work during Monday, Wednesday and Friday lunch times and for 3 after school clubs each week. We will also be running alongside these in school cricket and football clubs run by a member of staff. This allows us to continue offering 7 sports and exercise clubs to the children right across the school including a Change 4 Life club where we intend to engage children and their parents in health and well-being learning as well as activity. In turn we hope that this brings about a sustainable legacy of sport minded and active children throughout their school experience here with us.

We have replenished our PE equipment to ensure that lessons can be taught to a high level, allowing every child to access the learning and resources required.

We have also brought in a new scheme of work called 'imoves' to help improve teaching and learning throughout school and provide a consistent approach to teaching PE. We have signed up for a 3 year contract at £500 per year.

How We Spent Last Year's Allocation: 2015-2016

We signed up to the Arches School Sport Partnership 'GOLD' package at a cost of £1800. This enabled us to participate in every competition that was on offer throughout the city during the year.

In addition to this we also hired sports coaches from Arches to help improve the amount of sport on offer each lunchtime, and for 3 after school clubs a week.

How It Has Made A Difference: 2015-2016

We have been able to increase the amount of CPD training that staff have been on by being a member of the Arches package. Our PE teacher, Y3 team and various other school staff have been on 19 curriculum based courses to help improve the delivery of lessons and after school clubs.

Each class now receives an hour of high quality PE taught by the Archers PE Specialist plus a following hour taught by their class teacher. The class teachers are supported by the 'imoves' scheme of work in the planning and delivery of PE meaning all PE lessons are of a high quality. We monitor the teaching of PE as part of the school cycle of lesson observations.

We entered multiple competitions during the year. We were able to establish links through competition with local schools at our cluster finals. This has also helped us to establish club links with a number of clubs allowing children to access further pathways of learning.

There were 30 different after school clubs, catering for 1,044 participants, 588 boys and 456 girls across FS2, KS1 and KS2. These clubs were able to target many children who are on Pupil Premium.

We achieved a Bronze Sainsbury's School Games Kite Mark for 2015-2016
