



Science Subject Overview 2015-16

Science is a Core Subject at Hucklow. Science enables children to develop their understanding of the nature, processes and methods of science through different types of science enquiries that help them to answer scientific questions about the world around them. Children are equipped with the scientific knowledge required to understand the uses and implications of science, today and for the future.

Speaking, listening and communication is promoted to develop pupil's spoken language. The quality and variety of language that pupils hear and speak are key factors in developing their scientific vocabulary and articulating scientific concepts clearly and precisely.

Science is taught either an hour a week or the equivalent over theme days. Children will evidence their learning in art, writing, photographs, music, technology and speaking and listening. This will be recorded in Curriculum books and Class Handbooks.
